



DONATION POLICY

All gifts to American Jesuits International, a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization located in Washington, D.C., are tax-deductible in the United States to the extent permitted by law. American Jesuits International's Federal Tax ID number (EIN) is: 30-0341787

American Jesuits International (AJI) will retain a percentage of all private gifts, as detailed below, unless otherwise indicated and/or agreed upon, and has final discretion in the use of all donated funds. As required by law, all assets contributed to funds held by American Jesuits International become irrevocable gifts to American Jesuits International, and as a result, legal control and responsibility for such assets rests with American Jesuits International.

Assets contributed to American Jesuits International are subject to American Jesuits International's variance power, as set forth in the organization's bylaws. Variance power gives American Jesuits International the authority to modify any restrictions or conditions on the distribution of funds for any specified charitable purpose(s) and/or specified organization(s). In the event that a distribution cannot be made to a specified organization, campaign, program, or project, American Jesuits International will select an alternate grantee to receive the funds.

AJI will apply a 10% indirect support cost (ISC) rate on restricted private funding directly received by AJI to support specific partners, programs, and/or campaigns as designated by the donor. The 10% ISC rate will be used for AJI support services, which include advocacy, communications, fundraising, financial oversight, and management, as well as time spent to monitor and report on programs.

AJI will also apply an ISC rate to unrestricted private funding received by AJI to support its Greatest Need fund. This ISC rate will be determined by the AJI Finance + Development Committee and approved by the AJI Board of Directors on an annual basis.
